

Bio for Henry B. (Buddy) Everage:

Buddy Everage is a recognized leader in the earned value management community with over 20 years of financial management and earned value management (EVM) experience in both government and industry. During that time he has been involved in organizational and business process improvements in project management and financial management, and the design, development and implementation of earned value management systems. He is currently a Director within the Transportation, Energy, and DoD (TED) Division of MCR, LLC, where he provides support to Federal government agencies in all areas related to EVM systems development, implementation, maintenance and training.

Prior to joining MCR in September 2008 Mr. Everage was the Corporate Director, Earned Value Management System (EVMS) Programs for Computer Sciences Corporation (CSC) Federal Sector in Falls Church, VA. In this role Mr. Everage initiated and deployed a strategy for the development and implementation of an American National Standard Institute (ANSI) compliant EVMS that was applied across CSC's seven business areas.

Mr. Everage has also held senior EVM consulting positions where he provided subject matter expertise to defense contractors and Federal Government agencies in the areas of EVMS implementation and integrated project management.

Mr. Everage represents MCR as a member of the Executive Committee of the National Defense Industrial Association's (NDIA) Program Management Systems Committee (PMSC). He was the primary author and working group lead of the *NDIA EVMS System Acceptance Guide* as well as a co-author to the *NDIA Program Manager's Guide to the Integrated Baseline Review Process*.

Mr. Everage has provided presentations addressing earned value management and project management at several forums including the Project Management Institute's Washington, DC Chapter meetings, the annual International Integrated Program Management Conference, and the Project Management Institute sponsored EVM Conference Japan 2005 and 2006. In addition, Mr. Everage served as the co-chairperson for the 18th Annual International Integrated Program Management Conference 2006.

Mr. Everage retired from the naval service in 1994 after twenty-one years as a Naval Flight Officer. In addition to achieving the designations of P-3C Mission Commander and Patrol Plane Tactical Coordinator, he acquired significant experience in financial management and acquisition management. He holds B.S., M.S. and M.B.A. degrees.
