He was the FCS Milestone B program manager responsible for leading the transition of the FCS program from the Concept & Technology Demonstration phase into the SDD phase and currently is responsible for all Combat Systems efforts, including the Future Rapid Effects System program for the UK MOD and British Army and several pro-

James A. Rispoli, P.E.

James Rispoli was confirmed by the United States Senate as the Assistant Secretary of Energy for Environmental Management and was appointed on August 10, 2005. He is responsible for the cleanup of legacy waste and environmental contamination from the nation's Cold War nuclear weapon production and nuclear-related research activities. The Department's cleanup program has a current annual budget of more than \$6.5 billion with operations occurring in over a dozen states. Prior to his current position, Mr. Rispoli, a licensed professional engineer, held the office of Director of the Department of Energy's Office of Engineering and Construction Management.
